
Project Inspiration Pavilion

Walldorf

Stuttgart architecture office Scope developed the design and the interior design for this temporary exhibition building. The architecture of the pavilion is influenced by its position in a courtyard of the SAP headquarters. The building comprises two polygonal volumes that appear to break static boundaries and almost seem to fuse together. The different heights and shapes of the two volumes react to the programmatic structure of the exhibition. The smaller black volume functions as connective corridor to the foyer of the headquarters. Strips of black wood follow the line of the entrance and cover it like a second skin. The delicate wooden strips create an additional differentiation between the two volumes. The entrance to the building is located at the interface between the two volumes. The exhibition room is divided into three zones that inform visitors about the company's development.


